WP Objectives

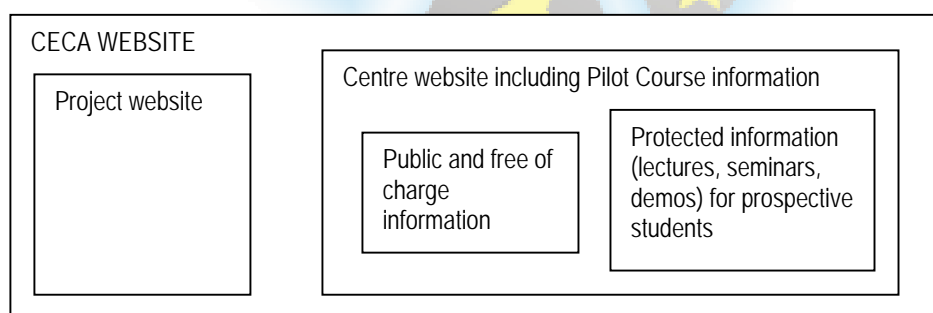
- To establish the appropriate information to be published on the CECA web-site

Introduction
